



Executive Order No. 20-20-A
Series of 2020

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER EXTENDING THE DURATION OF THE
ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE OVER THE PROVINCE OF
NEGROS OCCIDENTAL UNTIL APRIL 30, 2020**

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 929 series of 2020, wherein Local Government Units are enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the Local Government Code provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and promote health and safety, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, as a disease prevention and control measure in limiting the transmission of COVID-19 in the province, the Provincial Health Office has recommended the extension of the duration of the Enhanced Community Quarantine in the Province of Negros Occidental;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EUGENIO JOSE V. LACSON, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as Governor of the Province of Negros Occidental, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE. The Enhanced Community Quarantine over the entire Province of Negros Occidental is hereby extended until 11:59 pm of April 30, 2020. The provisions of Executive Order 20-20, Series of 2020 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF THE VALIDITY OF ECQ PASSES. The validity of all ECQ passes issued by the Province of Negros Occidental are deemed extended until 11:59 pm of April 30, 2020.

SECTION 3. MANDATORY USE OF FACE MASK. The provisions of Executive Order 20-22, Series of 2020 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
