



Executive Order No. 20-23-A
Series of 2020

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER SUSPENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 3.3.2 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-23, SERIES OF 2020

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2020, the Province of Negros Occidental was placed under General Community Quarantine by virtue of Executive Order No. 20-23, series of 2020 until 11:59PM of May 15, 2020 wherein one of the provisions is Section 3.3.2 which provides for the regulations on the use of the Road Roll-on and Roll-off (RORO) System in the Province of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, regulating the RORO in the province will require the approval of the Inter-agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-IED) prior to the implementation of Section 3.3.2 of E.O No. 20-23, series of 2020. Therefore, the implementation of Section 3.3.2 of E.O No. 20-23, series of 2020 needs to be suspended until further orders;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EUGENIO JOSE V. LACSON, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as Governor of the Province of Negros Occidental, do hereby order the suspension of the implementation of Section 3.3.2 of Executive Order No. 20-23, series of 2020 until the said provision has been reviewed and approved by the Inter-agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-IED).

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
